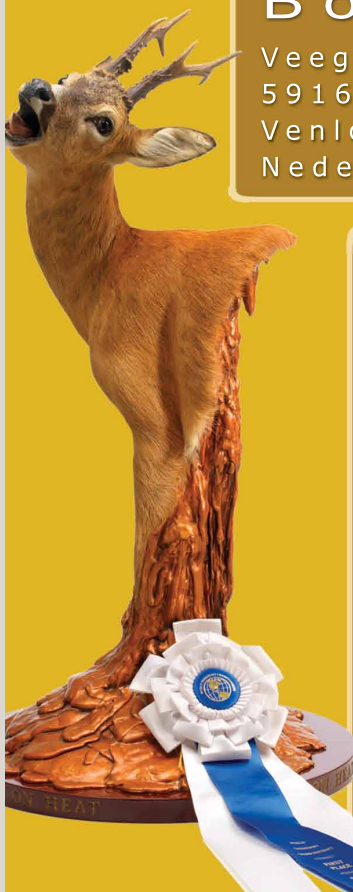

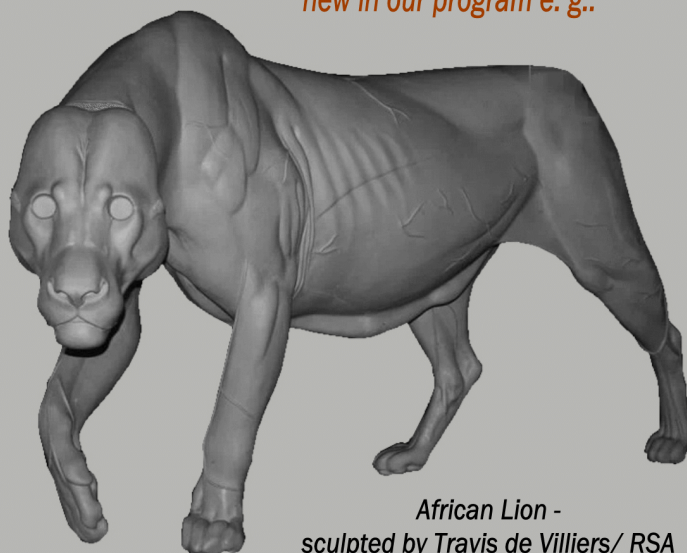

For the third mount, the competitor is free to place an amphibian, a reptile or a fish into the NR, RP or RSM categories.
Note: Niels Henning Gustafsson (1940 - 2008) was a taxidermist, one of the first in Denmark who introduced new artistic ways for mounting animals. He was one of the founders of the DZK in 1974. At his death, he donated his fortune to the DZK.

NOVICE AWARD

Awarded to the best three pieces in Novice division according to the Rules & Regulations. Selected from: Novice division.

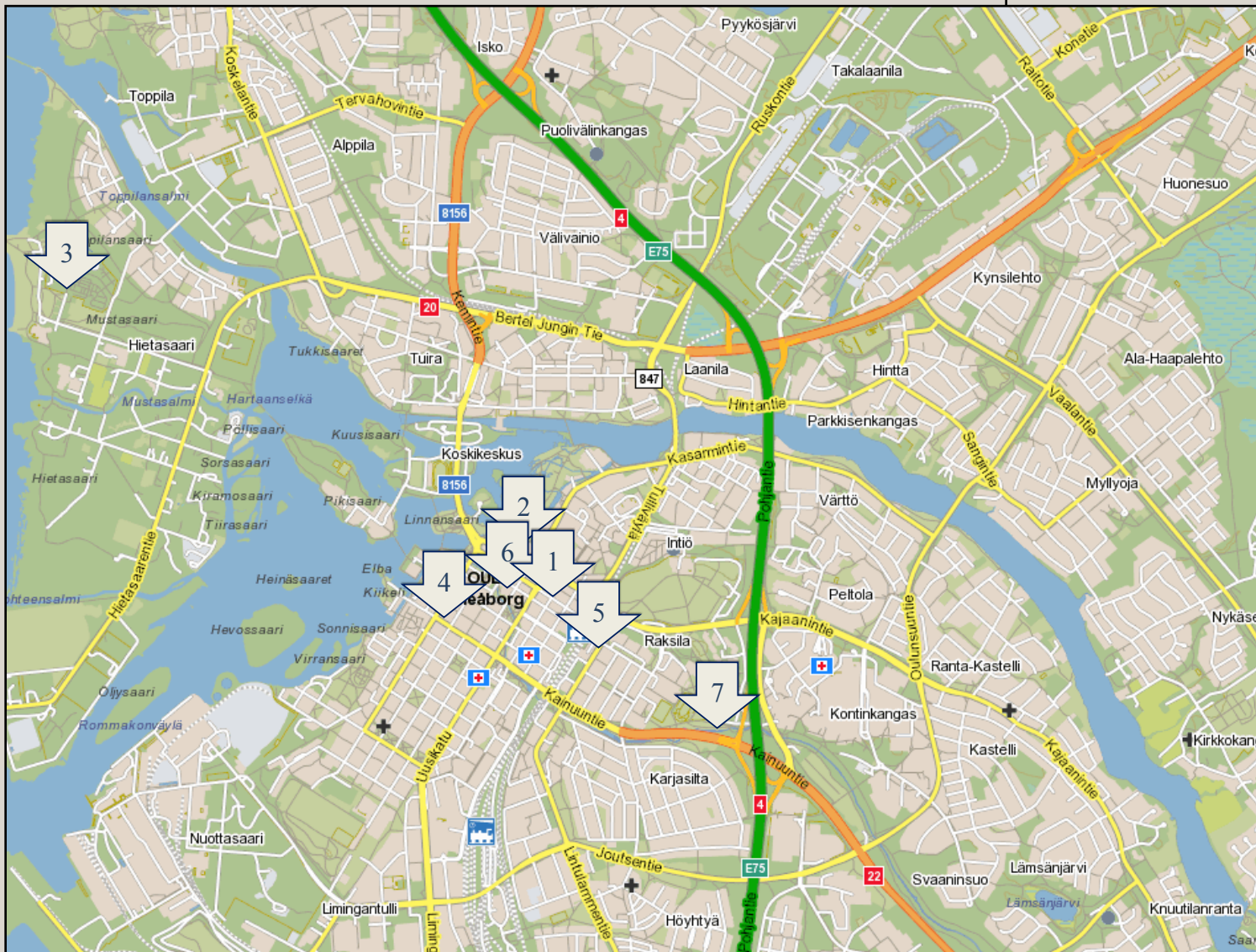
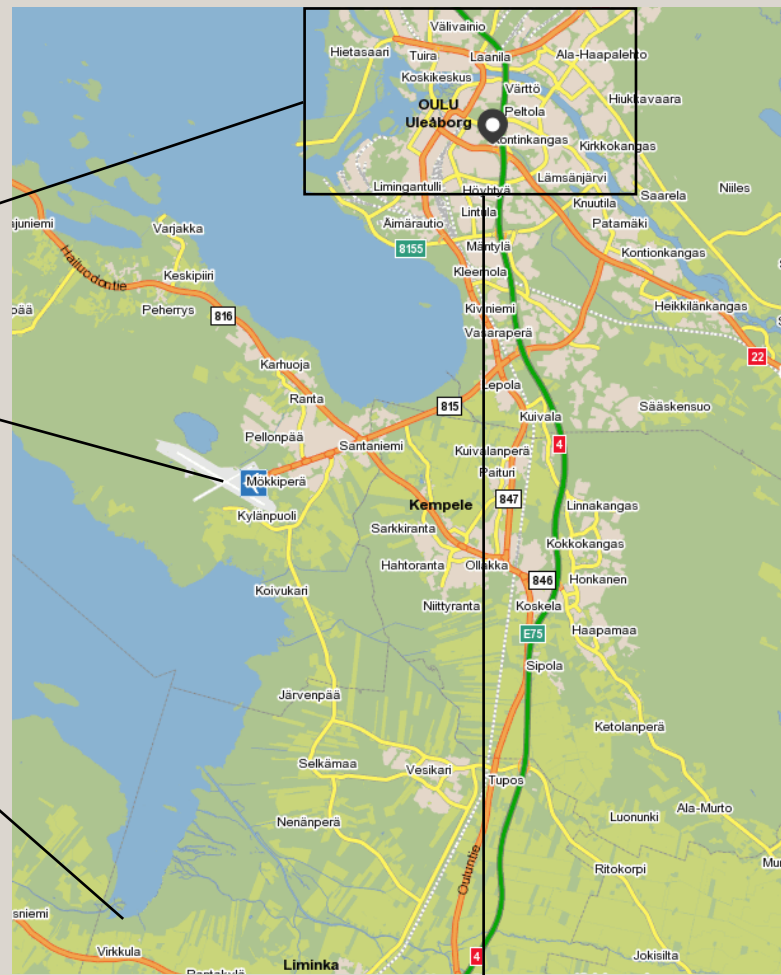
